# **LEARNING SUPPORT COACH** (FOR ALL STUDENTS)

# **LEARNING SUPPORT PRACTITIONER** (FOR SPECIFIC STUDENTS)

Our Learning Support Practitioners offer a timetable of supportive small group sessions on each campus, these are on offer for students with an Inclusive Teaching Plan. The sessions are planned with the group and are there to help you stay up to date with your studies and also meet your EHCP outcomes (if you have an EHCP).

Some students can also access a 1:1 supportive teaching session, the Inclusion Coordinators on each site manage this process - ask to be referred if you have an ITP or an EHCP.

#### APPRENTICESHIP RECRUITMENT EXECUTIVE
