Setting Up the Microsoft Authenticator App



If you have already installed Microsoft Authenticator app, delete the app, and reinstall it.

You will need to use your own data and disable any VPN.

You will need to enable Notifications for MS Teams and Authenticator.

- **1.** Log in to a PC, laptop or use your mobile phone to login to <u>www.derby-college.ac.uk</u>.
- 2. Enter www.derby-college.ac.uk in the address bar on your browser and press Enter.

3. Click on the My Signins link to log in to your college Microsoft Account.



4. Click on your **initials** or avatar in the top-right corner of the page.



5. Click on View Account.

Any changes may take up to 24 hours to take effect.
