Class 2	Class 2 - Normal 40cm – but all welcome to wear fancy dress		
Class 2A	Class 2A – Ride and Run – You will ride over the first half of the course then hand your pony to your helper and complete the course on foot – fastest clear runner wins		
Class 3 No Fillers	Class 3 - Accumulator – From poles to 55cm – each fence will have a points value depending on its height and you will have 60 seconds to jump any of the fences in any order and the person who is clear and gains highest amount of points will win. Fences can be jumped more than once but only in the correct direction		
Class 4	Class 4 – Normal 60cm class – but all welcome to wear fancy dress		
Class 4a	Class 4A - 60cm – Post a letter to Santa – You will jump the first phase as normal then in the timed section you will be given a letter to Santa to carry over the jumps and post at the end – fastest clear i the times section will win		
Class 5	Class 5 – Normal 70cm class – but all welcome to wear fancy dress		
Class 6	Class 6 and 6A - Usual 80cm Class combined with PC Qualifier – but all welcome to wear fancy dress

Terms & Conditions of Entry

- 1. Entries cost £15 per class PC £17 per class which must be paid in cash or card <u>on the day of the event</u>. ANYONE WHO ENTERS AND DOES NOT PAY FOR ANY REASON WILL HAVE FUTURE ENTRIES REFUSED.
- 2. There will be a caterer & photographer at all our events.
- 3. All competitors must sign a perpetual disclaimer which will be valid for every riding session at Derby College.
- 4. Withdrawals must be received by the Wednesday before competition, otherwise entry fees MUST still be paid
- 5. In case of the event having to be cancelled due to bad weather an announcement will be put on the Derby College Facebook page, or phone 07980 891295 on the show day if you are unsure.
- 6. The Winter SJ Series is a relaxed, fun event. Competitors and their supporters are expected to enter into the spirit of the event and be friendly and supportive of fellow competitors.
- 7. Novice horses and riders are welcome and will be given chance to end on a good note within their time slot.
- 8. The event organisers reserve the right to refuse or revoke any entry without explanation.
- 9. The event organisers accept no responsibility for accidents, injury or loss to competitors, spectators, animals or equipment. Admission is granted and entries accepted on these conditions.
- 10. All horses and riders must have adequate 3rd party insurance. We also recommend accident insurance for all competitors.
- 11. The Judge's or Event Organiser's decision is final in all respects. Stewards' instructions must be adhered to.
- 12. Riders must be an appropriate size/weight for their horses/ponies.
- 13. British Show Jump rules will be followed, except where expressly stated.
- 14. Helmet cameras may not be worn.
- 15. The Event Organisers reserve the right to cancel or split any class or substitute judges without explanation.
- 16. Dogs are not permitted on college grounds.
- 17. Only competitors may ride their horses at the competition, and this must be in the warmup ring only. No lunging is permitted. For safety reasons, only 8 people permitted in the warmup at any one time. Preference is given to the next 8 competitors.
- 18. There will be **no** first aid cover at events.

Entries are accepted on the understanding that competitors agree to abide by these rules.
